

ORDINANCE #2009-09

ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LACEY, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 323 OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LACEY, ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC," SO AS TO AMEND SECTION 323-27, ENTITLED "SCHEDULE IV: THROUGH STREETS"

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Lacey, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 323-27 of the Township code of the Township of Lacey, entitled "Schedule IV: Through Streets," is hereby amended and supplemented to provide for the addition of the following through street:

NAME OF STREET

LIMITS

Deerhead Lake Drive

Between Lakeside Drive North/Lakeside Drive to its intersection with Llewellyn Parkway

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

SECTION 4. The municipal engineer, under his seal as a licensed professional engineer, certified to the governing body, that any designation has been approved by the engineer after investigation of the circumstances, appears to the engineer to be in the interest of safety and the expedition of traffic on the public highways, and conforms to the current standards prescribed by the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways, as adopted by the commissioner.

SECTION 5. The provisions of the ordinance are consistent with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways, consistent with accepted engineering standards,

based on the results of an accurate traffic and engineering survey, and does not place an undue traffic burden or impact on streets in an adjoining municipality or negatively affect the flow of traffic on the State highway system

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect after second reading and publication as required by law.

Dear Ms. Laureigh:

In regard to the above noted project, Deer Head Lake Drive will now act as the through street past the realigned beach area and parking lot. By this new configuration, beach users will no longer have to cross the roadway for access to the recreation area. After investigating the circumstances and actual conditions in the area, this appears to be in the best interest of safety and the expedition of traffic on the public roadway. These modifications conform to the current standards prescribed by the MUTCD as adopted by the New Jersey Department of Transportation Commissioner. We therefore recommend amending the Township traffic ordinance to reflect this change.

Deer Head Lake Drive should be designated as the through street from Lakeside Drive North across Lakeside Drive South all the way to Llewellyn Parkway. This will facilitate the proposed traffic control signage anticipated upon completion of the project. Part of the work will include stop signs at the intersection with Lake Side South.
