

ORDINANCE #07- 40

**ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LACEY, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 323 OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE, ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC," SO AS TO AMEND SECTION 323-28 ENTITLED "SCHEDULE V: STOP AND YIELD INTERSECTIONS" SO AS TO PROVIDE FOR ADDITIONAL STOP AND YIELD INTERSECTIONS IN THE TOWNSHIP OF LACEY**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Lacey, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Section 323-28 of the Township Code of the Township of Lacey, entitled "Schedule V: Stop and Yield Intersections," is hereby amended and supplemented to provide for additional stop and yield intersections as follows:

<b>Intersection</b>	<b>Stop Sign On</b>
Enterprise Drive and Normandie Drive	Enterprise Drive

**SECTION 2.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 3.** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not effect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

**SECTION 4.** Regulatory and warning signs shall be erected and maintained to effect the above-designated through streets and stop and yield intersections as authorized by the Department of Transportation.

**SECTION 5.** This ordinance shall take effect after second reading and publication as required by law, and upon approval by the Commissioner of Transportation.
