OCEAN COUNTY MAYORS' ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIPS 2025

GENERAL STATEMENT:

The Ocean County Mayors' Association is sponsoring 21 - \$1,000 (4-year accredited high schools) and 4 - \$500 (Ocean County Vocational-Technical Schools) scholarships to be given annually to high school seniors residing in Ocean County in accordance with the conditions listed below. The administration of the scholarships will be under the direction of the Ocean County Superintendents' Roundtable. All funds shall be raised and maintained by the Mayors' Association. In addition, interested students should contact their guidance counselor for any additional information that may be required. ALL RECIPIENTS MUST BE RESIDENTS OF OCEAN COUNTY. Deadline to receive all materials is Friday, May 2, 2025.

CONDITIONS:

- 1. <u>Eligibility</u>: One graduating senior class member from each four-year accredited high school (21) in Ocean County for the Mayors' Scholarships and one graduating senior for the OCMA's "special" scholarships: Russell K. Corby Scholarship (Special Education), William W. Curtis (Health Science Interest), Arthur P. Petracco (Student Furthering Their Education), and David Siddons Scholarship (Political Science)— see criteria for these special scholarships below.
- 2. <u>Awardee Characteristics</u>: Award winners shall have demonstrated excellence in academics. They shall have an expressed interest in government. They shall have documented a history of service to their school and/or home communities.
- 3. Ocean County Vocational Technical School: Four (4) \$500 scholarships shall be awarded to Ocean County students attending Ocean County Vocational Technical Schools (i.e. the Toms River, Jackson, Waretown and Brick centers) and three (3) \$1,000 scholarships shall be awarded to Ocean County students attending Ocean County Vocational Technical Academies (MATES, GPAA and ALPS).
- 4. **Funding**: Funding for the scholarships shall be provided by the Ocean County Mayors' Association. The amount of the scholarships shall be determined annually by the Ocean County Mayors' Association.
- 5. <u>Selection Process</u>: Within the limits of the general provisions established for the scholarships, all selection procedures shall be determined by the Ocean County Superintendents' Roundtable.
- 6. <u>Presentation</u>: Presentation of the scholarships shall be at the Annual Ocean County Superintendents' Roundtable Student Recognition Breakfast.
- 7. **Photographs**: A non-returnable photograph of the student is required to be submitted along with the scholarship application.
- 8. <u>William T. Hornidge Scholarship</u>: One (1) \$1,000 scholarship is awarded to a student with the highest academic record achieved during the four years attendance in high school. The committee chooses this winner based on the schools' submissions for the Mayors' Scholarship. The criteria for judging the highest shall be as follows:
 - 1) Since different high schools have varying methods of quantifying all academic excellence, all student grade point averages that equal the top score awarded shall be considered equal.
 - 2) In the case of a tie, the second tie-breaker shall be the highest SAT score.
 - 3) In the case of an additional tie, consideration shall be given to public service performed within the school or within the community
- 9. Russell K. Corby Scholarship: One (1) \$1,000 scholarship is awarded to a student with interest in "special education". Students must have a family member present or past that is/was an elected official. Multiple nominees accepted.
- 10. William W. Curtis Scholarship: One (1) \$1,000 scholarship is awarded to a student with an interest in "health sciences". Students must have a family member present or past that is/was an elected official. Multiple nominees accepted.
- 11. Arthur P. Petracco Memorial Scholarship: One (1) \$1,000 scholarship is awarded to a student "furthering their education". Students must have a family member present or past that is/was an elected official. Multiple nominees accepted.
- 12. <u>David M. Siddons Scholarship</u>: One (1) \$1,000 scholarship is awarded to a student with a "political science" interest. Students must have a family member present or past that is/was an elected official. Multiple nominees accepted.
- 13. Ocean County College: The Ocean County Mayors' Association shall give to the Trustees of the Ocean County College scholarship fund an amount of money (currently \$5,000) that shall be distributed by the Trustees in accordance with their scholarship criteria to incoming Ocean County College Freshmen.
- 14. Submission: The completed application must be returned to the school guidance counselor to then be submitted to Allison Erwin no later than Friday, May 2, 2025. Ocean County Mayor's Scholarship - Blue Form

School staff will submit ONE student <u>per high school</u> for the Mayor's Scholarship (\$1,000). This is the student with the <u>highest academic record</u>. The SCHOOL will determine this recipient and send in their profile on the blue highlighted form.

From all of those Mayors' Scholarship recipients, ONE winner county-wide will be chosen by the committee to also receive the William T. Hornidge Scholarship (\$1,000).

Russell K. Corby Scholarship

Schools may submit multiple nominees for the Russell K. Corby Scholarship

One (1) \$1,000 scholarship is awarded to a student with interest in special Education.

Students must have a family member present or past that is/was an elected official.

From those submissions, the Mayors' Association will choose ONE winner county-wide to receive the Russell K. Corby Scholarship.

William W. Curtis Scholarship

Schools may submit multiple nominees for the William W. Curtis Scholarship.

One (1) \$1,000 scholarship is awarded to a student with an interest in Health Sciences.

Students must have a family member present or past that is/was an elected official.

From those submissions, the Mayors' Association will choose ONE winner county-wide to receive the William W. Curtis Scholarship.

Arthur P. Petracco Memorial Scholarship

Schools may submit multiple nominees for the Arthur P. Petracco Memorial Scholarship.

One (1) \$1,000 scholarship is awarded to a student furthering their education.

Students must have a family member present or past that is/was an elected official.

From those submissions, the Mayors' Association will choose ONE winner county-wide to receive the Arthur P. Petracco Memorial Scholarship.

David M. Siddons Scholarship

Schools may submit multiple nominees for the David M. Siddons Scholarship.

One (1) \$1,000 scholarship is awarded to a student with a political science interest.

Students must have a family member present or past that is/was an elected official.

From those submissions, the Mayors' Association will choose ONE winner county-wide to receive the David M. Siddons Scholarship.
